

Parents Code of Conduct

- Parents must be courteous at all times to everyone, including skaters and their fellow parents in accordance with the Skate Canada's <u>Code of Ethics</u>.
- For insurance reasons, Parents/Guardians are not permitted on the ice surface.
- Parents, Guardians or designate should remain in the arena for the entire session (until the child reaches 12 years of age), unless a designated parent has been assigned/contact information left with Coach.
- Coaches are not to be disturbed during lessons/practice times.
- Parents shall refrain from any behaviour or comments which are profane, insulting, harassing, sexist, racist, abusive, disrespectful or otherwise offensive.
- Parents shall emphasize the importance of values like sportsmanship, respect, cooperation, competition and teamwork to their child offering praise for competing fairly, participation and skill development.
- Parents shall instill confidence in their child's ability and skill development, avoiding comparisons with other skaters.
- Parents shall celebrate the acquisition of skills and goals achieved by their child.
- Parents, along with the professional coach and the athlete, shall be considered members of a team whose main concern is the child's overall progress and development.
- Parents shall respect that the professional coach is responsible and empowered for the on-ice and off-ice development of the athlete.
- Parents shall ensure their child wears proper skating clothing and equipment.
- Parents shall adhere to the policies, procedures, rules, standards, and ethics of the
 Matrix Synchronized Skating Academy and Skate Canada at all times.
- Parents will not use technology or social media to disrespect or exploit others.
- Parents are not allowed to record another child that is not their own unless they have consent from said parent.
- Concerns/Complaints will be reviewed only if submitted in writing to the Matrix Synchronized Skating Academy committee.
- Parents should not be communicating with their child while they are on the ice.

- If a complaint is made in writing to the skating club committee (matrixsynchronizedteams@gmail.com), the incident will be reviewed and disciplinary action may be taken.
- I acknowledge that failure to comply with the Parent Code of Conduct by myself, or any member of my family, will result in disciplinary action up to and including revocation of membership.
- I understand that by accepting a position on a team I'm also accepting all financial obligations for the season. Not fulfilling your financial obligation can result in you being put as a member in bad standings.
- Be prepared that some events may have to be altered, delayed or canceled. (galas, ice dog games, competitions etc.) because of reasons beyond Matrix
 Synchronized Skating Academy's control.
